Other benefits of this design include no welding required at the job site as our components are designed to be bolted or screwed together. Secondary framing is all steel and on 2' centers so that all exterior siding is fastened directly to secondary framing. The net result is that you get a stronger building at a lower cost and now you can get an 80 foot wide free span building!
